Asilomar is a breathtakingly beautiful 107 acres of protected beachfront land within the scenic town of Pacific Grove on the world-famous Monterey Peninsula. Ecologically diverse, the grounds are a mix of California's most pristine sand dunes, unspoiled beaches and towering pine forests. Since 1913, Asilomar has played host to thousands of groups and conferences seeking a productive environment in a unique and natural setting.



30 historic buildings, many designed by famed architect Julia Morgan, house 313 guest rooms and 30,000 square feet of inspirational meeting space. Group rates include three meals per day, plus a general session meeting room, making Asilomar a financial value way beyond compare. Free Wi-Fi is available every day in all sleeping rooms and the Hearst Social Hall. Our new ‘Phoebe’s Café’ offers light fare, and wine & beer in a relaxing setting on the ocean-view deck or by the fireplace.

Harmonizing with its surroundings, Asilomar Conference Grounds has played host to thousands of groups since its first campsite meeting in 1913. Now greeting groups of fifteen to 1,000, the grounds feature 28 meeting rooms, from the 550-seat Merrill Hall to the intimate, living rooms found in most guest room lodges. Since all function rooms are within walking distance of each other, meetings can begin in the spacious auditorium halls, and then convene to smaller rooms for breakout sessions.



TRANSPORTATION

Airplane

- Monterey Peninsula Airport is 8 miles away and has 28 flights daily from San Francisco, LAX, Phoenix, Denver, San Diego, and Las Vegas airports on American, United, US Air, Alaska and Allegiant Air.
- San Jose International Airport is 65 miles away, (1 hour 20 minute drive).
- San Francisco International Airport is 126 miles away (2 hour drive) and a short 20 minute flight on United Airlines into the Monterey Airport.

Shuttle

- The Monterey Airbus offers reserved 'non-stop' shuttle airport transfers from both San Francisco and San Jose International Airports to the Asilomar door for approximately \$50 each way.
